1. WHAT KIND OF SECURITY IS IN PLACE FOR MY CHILD?

Parents are required to check in their child at any of our children's check-in desks. Children will be given a printed name tag with their name and a security number. Should a problem arise during the service, parents will be notified using this number. After the service, parents must present their portion of the numbered security tags to pick up their child at his or her classroom.

2. WHAT KIND OF SECURITY CHECK IS USED FOR VOLUNTEERS?

For the safety of all children, Prairie Lakes Church requires all children's volunteer workers and paid staff to have a background check before serving in our children's department.

3. WHAT WILL MY CHILD DO DURING THE SERVICE?

They will master biblical concepts through creative activities. We believe that less is more so, through repetition, we hope that by age five your child will understand and believe:

1. God Made Me.
2. God Loves Me.
3. Jesus Wants to Be My Friend Forever.

4. WHY DO THE WINGS CLOSE 15 MINUTES AFTER THE SERVICE BEGINS?

To allow children to participate in all aspects of their classroom's programming and eliminate disruptions in both the classrooms and Worship Center, all Children's Ministry classes will close 15 minutes after each service begins. Parents and children may view the worship service via live feed on our television in Room 137 off the Café.

5. AT TIMES, THERE ARE ROOMS CLOSED. WHY DOES THIS HAPPEN?

Our Children's Ministry is experiencing rapid growth! While we strive to staff our rooms with enough volunteers to handle peak volumes of children, we are now feeling the pinch of more children than volunteers!

Your children's safety is of utmost importance to us and we will begin enforcing the following procedural ratios in our children's wings effective October 10 & 11, 2009, closing rooms when the following safety ratios are met:

- Infants - 1 adult: max 3 children
- Toddlers/Scooters - 1 adult: max 3 children
- Twos - 1 adult: max 4 children
- Threes - 1 adult: max 5 children
- Fours - 1 adult: max 5 children
- Fives - 1 adult: max 6 children

Parents: Please consider volunteering in your child's room once or twice for one service each month. Tell the area coordinator in your children's room/wing that you'd like to volunteer and pick up a volunteer application at the Connection Desk.
